

Notice at Collection to Applicants Residing in California

Coinbase, Inc., Coinbase Custody Trust Company, LLC and its related entities (together, “Coinbase” or the “Company”) is aware of its obligations under the California Consumer Privacy Act (“CCPA”) and is committed to processing your data securely and transparently. This privacy notice sets out, in line with CCPA, the categories of data that we may collect on you as a candidate of the Company and the purposes for which the categories of Personal Information shall be used.

For purposes of this notice, “**Personal Information**” means information that identifies, relates to, describes, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a natural person that the Company collects about its applicants, who reside in California, in their capacity as applicants for positions with the Company.

We may collect, use and disclose your Personal Information for other purposes not listed in this notice. If we do so, we will make it known to you at the time we collect, use or disclose your Personal Information and obtain your consent.

Protecting Your Personal Information

We are aware of the requirement to ensure your Personal Information is protected against accidental loss or disclosure, destruction and abuse. We have implemented processes to guard

against such. These policies and procedures are covered as part of our information security program.

Where we share your Personal Information with third parties it is only pursuant to a legal obligation, and we provide written instructions to them to ensure that your Personal Information is held securely and in line with applicable privacy laws and regulations. Third parties must implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of your Personal Information. We do not sell your Personal Information.
